## THE ANKIT SAJWAN STORY

In 2013 we met **Ankit Sajwan**, a humble young man in his mid 20s, with a burning passion for Jesus Christ. Our close associate Robert Devens brought Ankit to attend one of our campaigns in **Aligarh**,

**North India.** Ankit was just starting in ministry. We invited him to share in a small leadership conference we were conducting. We were instantly drawn to this unassuming young man and could see the strong anointing on his life.

Ankit was raised a devout practicing Hindu. His mother

was processed by guardian spirit. Growing up he was tormented by the spirit in his mother. At one time the spirit manifested in the middle of the night and his mother stood with a dagger ready to kill her entire family because they had not offered worship to this demon spirit. They cried out for mercy. He gave his life to Christ in 2006. After this he had many supernatural encounters with Jesus. Hearing His audible voice. Jesus told him he would never have to fear the demon that was in his mother again. His mother was delivered and the demon ran out of their house.

He launched a small house church in New Delhi in 2013. Robert helped him often in those days. Sharmila and I also spoke at his church. Initially, they lacked financially, the rest of the

congregation sat on the floor and only had one chair, for his pregnant wife Monika to sit

on. From the very inception, this small church began to experience miracles, healings, signs and wonders. Even the dead were raised and they began growing.

Ankit began traveling with Robert and us in many of our outreaches to India and Nepal. Many times when he prayed over people undeniable miracles occurred. It was very evident to

Sharmila and I that this young man would flourish in ministry. A number of times Sharmila had specific prophetic words for him which have all come to pass.

In our outreach to **Sitargunj, India** in 2015 I did not sense the anointing to preach that night. Holy Spirit impressed upon me that Ankit should speak that night. He did a great job. On another

occasion in **Sukhar, Nepal**, I asked Robert and Ankit to start the leadership conference that we were conducting. I was going to teach after them. Turned out I never got to speak. When I arrived all the pastors and leaders were having encounters with Holy Spirit and all I could do is look on to see this sign and wonder taking place.

As the years progressed Holy Spirit began to expand Pastor Ankit's ministry. Oct 2024 Holy Spirit spoke to him and asked if he was ashamed of the call on his life. Ankit asked for clarification. He said I have called you to be Apostle to India. From that day forth he unashamedly took on the mantle of Apostle and his church rapidly expanded from 1500 to an average Sunday attendance of 6000 to 8000 in 2025. Family Lord Jesus Church building can only hold 5,000 people. The rest join the service from outside the sanctuary. On an average Sunday over 200,000 Indians tune in online to their Sunday morning services. They are getting ready to break ground on a sanctuary that will hold 20,000 people. Jesus appeared 2 years earlier, to the Hindu man that sold them the property. He waited until Ankit's people came along,

and gave him a great deal on this 8 acres.

At the beginning of 2024 they began conducting all night prayer meetings once a month where people would gather to pray from 11:00 PM to 6 AM. Average attendance for this prayer meeting is now 5,000. During these prayer meetings, undeniable

miracles breakout such as missing body parts being formed, cripples healed, tumors dissolve etc. Many other churches in India have adopted this prayer model.

Recently Pastor Ankit was invited to the capitol of **Jharkhand State, Ranchi** to conduct a three day outreach. They were planning for an

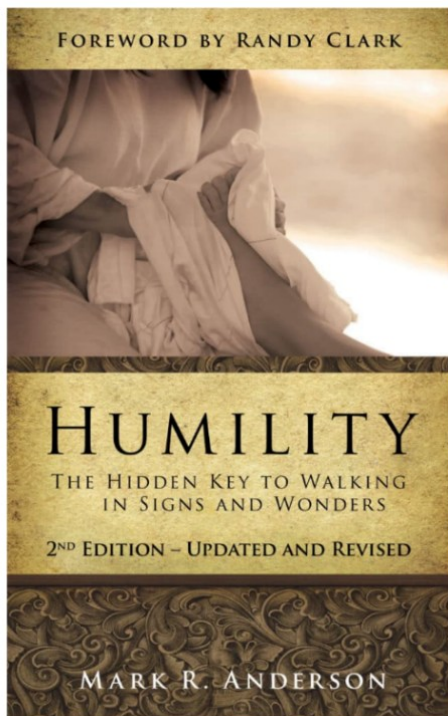
attendance of 150,000. The outreach was extended one more day and the closing night the crowd was estimated at 450,000. Many signs, wonders and miracles were reported. The Chief Minister sent his cabinet to attend the outreach and they stated they have never seen such a massive crowd. Jesus was glorified. Now many

cities all over India would like Ankit to come and conduct an outreach in their city.

Before Pastor Ankit conducted this outreach in Ranchi, Sharmila and I met



him at his church. At one time with tears streaming down his face he said to us, you believed in me when I was a nobody. You gave me an opportunity to minister in your outreach in 2015. He told me that my book **HUMILITY THE HIDDEN KEY TO WALKING IN SIGNS AND WONDERS** has had a tremendous impact on his life. He has read that book over and over again. It is very

evident that Christlike humility attracts the manifest glory of God to this earth like a magnet. That is what Ankit is experiencing on a regular basis. I told Pastor Ankit that he models humility a lot better than me, the author of the book.

## RAISING UP OTHERS TO BE MORE EFFECTIVE THAN YOURSELF!

Warning: I am plagiarizing from myself. This is mostly an excerpt from my book ***Humility the Hidden Key to Walking in Signs and Wonders*** (Written 2010). We are sharing this teaching because it has produced tremendous fruit.

Division and discord come as a result of the pride of man. As Christians, we are playing on the same team. We should not be in competition with each other. Rather we should each do our part, working together, to further the kingdom of God. Our desire should be to see those we train excel and supersede us. My desire is to see the ministry of those whom I train or mentor surpass my own ministry.

John the Baptist said, *“He [Jesus] must increase, but I must decrease”* ( John 3:30). John turned the attention that was on him toward Jesus, stepping out of Jesus’ way. He laid aside his privileges and pointed people to the one it’s all about: Jesus. If we can operate in the manner that Jesus and John the Baptist did, we can raise up individuals more effective than ourselves to do the



greater works and fulfill the Great Commission. We can greatly multiply our effect. If we decrease and the nature of Jesus increases in us, imagine the effect! There will be more Heaven on earth, more signs, wonders, miracles, and the “greater works” Jesus talked about (see John 14:12). This is how Christianity will multiply on the earth.

A number of years ago, a friend of ours, gave us a prophetic word that we have not forgotten. He told us our ministry would not attain great visibility. It would not grow upwards, but outwards, far reaching. This became a major part of our ministry, as others we helped along the way have greatly excelled.

We need to believe in and see the potential in other Christians. *The purposes of a man’s heart are deep waters, but a man of understanding*



*draws them out* (Proverbs 20:5 NIV). People have potential buried deep inside. It takes someone who sees the gold buried within people to bring that gold to the surface. If leaders are walking in arrogance regarding their ministries and only focusing on themselves, they will never see the gold buried in others, thereby limiting the move of God. God is raising up an army. For too long the focus has been only on the one-man show. That can set up a person for the fall. *Though the Lord is high, yet He regards the lowly. But the proud He knows from a far off* (Psalms 138:6). It is time we in ministry raise up others to be more effective than us. Holy Spirit will be able to do more as we allow Him to work through more people also.

There are many gifted men and women in the Body of Christ. If we truly understand, that is not just about our gift or ministry rather in raising up others, imparting, we would go far in multiplying the work of God. Our ceiling can be the next generation's floor. Team ministry can be so much more effective. It is all about Jesus, Him living His life through us and those He laid His life down for. It is unfortunate when gifted Christians love the preeminence because of their

gifts rather than multiplying the Kingdom of God. Their gifts could be greatly multiplied if they would only raise up others, but instead they want the preeminence and attention to be on them and their gifting. The apostle John wrote about this *I wrote to the church, but Diotrephes, who loves to have the preeminence among them, does not receive us* (3 John 9).

Those who love the preeminence do not receive or embrace other people's giftings in the Body because they want the attention on themselves; many times they are very insecure about others getting the attention. Insecurity (which is a form of pride) and jealousy are a great hindrance to the Gospel (see Proverbs 11:2).

How do you know if someone or yourself is loving or having the preeminence? Many times the talk will revolve around the person having the preeminence. I have been around many in ministry over the years and I would have say I do not like sitting around people who love having the preeminence. All they talk about is themselves and their own accomplishments but rarely take the time to know others around them. I remember being like that myself in the early days of ministry. One

way to avoid that is to show an interest in others by asking them about themselves, what God is doing in their life or speaking to them. That way it does not center on you and your accomplishments. In God's Kingdom, the way up is the way down. We should be willing to fit into whatever mold God wants us to be in and be willing to serve. *Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time* (1 Peter 5:6).

God's desire is to lift us up and take us beyond our self. In order for Him to do this, we need to be humble and obedient. Pride will always focus on one small part of the puzzle, but humility will affect the big picture, knowing that it is not just about our ministry or gifts. It's all about Jesus!

The leaders in Jesus' day operated in a false humility that was nothing more than a facade. They directed the focus of the people on all the sacrifices they made, which was false humility rooted in pride and arrogance. The religious spirit will try to divert the attention to an individual's personal cross and try to glorify it, rather than the cross of Christ. All this is done in subtle ways, by portraying what the leader has done for Jesus, the persecution,

hardships and sacrifices encountered for Him—but it's all centered on self. This is a clear contradiction of what Paul says in Galatians 6:14 *But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ....*

Jesus said in Matthew 6:1-6 that if we do it to be seen by people—our praying, fasting, giving, and sacrificing—then we have our reward; the glory of man. People will exalt and glorify us, but not God. We need to seek the favor of God above all else. If we do things for the **Audience of One** rather than to be seen by man, Jesus said the Father will reward you openly. What does that look like? An open heaven where Christlike humility attracts the manifested glory of God like a magnet to the earth and you walk in an open heaven.

The attention must always be on Jesus. Jesus told the Pharisees, *You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it* (John 8:44). The devil is the father of lies and pride. Pride causes exaggeration and lying. We need to be people of



integrity. Pride will cause us to be insecure in who God made us to be, boasting and exaggerating in our accomplishments. We do not have to be people-pleasers. Our security needs to be in God. We do not have to strive to make ourselves look good to others. True promotion comes from God, not people. Psalms 75:6-7 says *For exaltation comes neither from the east Nor from the west nor from the south. But God is the Judge: He puts down one, And exalts another.*

I exhort believers, especially those in ministry, not to exaggerate their own accomplishments. Also not to live on yesterday's victories alone. *...but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Therefore let us, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you* (Philippians 3:13-15). I encourage them to just lift up Jesus and what He is accomplishing. We must let people see that the focus is Jesus, not us and what we are doing. That is one way to keep from exaggeration and self-promotion, which can be a real turnoff to many and can

lead to a fall. Our humility will bless others. *My soul shall make its boast in the Lord; The humble shall hear of it and be glad* (Psalm 34:2).

It is sad when we begin to think that God cannot do anything of significance unless it is through us, our organization, or our ministry. Pride causes many to slow down or fall by the wayside with jealousy whenever God uses someone else more powerfully than them. Whatever gifts and talents we have as individuals or in a church organization come only by God's grace. Apart from Him, we can do nothing (see John 15:5). This should cause us to walk in humility.

When we humble ourselves, God increases the grace upon us to accomplish the task at hand. Who gets the grace? *But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble"* (James 4:6). The word **resist** is a military term which means **to range in battle against**. When we walk in pride, we are ranging in battle against God Himself. But if on the other hand we walk in Christ like humility His grace is available. The task at hand is to bring in the harvest of souls, as opposed to building our own little kingdom. Let us get back to the task at hand. Many of

us have humble beginnings. However when God begins to exalt us and gives us victories, we must be on the guard against the spirit of pride. It sneaks up most of the time right after a great victory.

**Your success can lead to your fall.** *Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall* (Proverbs 16:18). Even though we may start off walking in humility, it is no guarantee that we will continue the same way. The greater our accomplishments, the greater the danger we face of becoming full of pride. Steward your success for His glory and honor and his glory will continue to manifest around you. We must guard our hearts from pride and arrogance. **Humility will cause God** to continue to exalt us and **increase the grace for the call He has placed on our life.** It will help us to stand strong and go much farther.

Randy Clark, who operates in one of the most powerful modern day healing anointing, said in the foreword of this book, humility was so very important to the great outpouring that spread worldwide out of Toronto. Holy Spirit spoke this to him just before going to Toronto. Randy's words "I will never forget the message's meaning: *"This is the most dangerous moment of your life. If you*

*touch the glory, become proud, fail to stay humble, this anointing will destroy you."* I have watched in my lifetime one minister after another fall because they did not understand or comprehend these words spoken to Randy before Holy Spirit began to use Him so powerfully throughout the world. I have watched the very anointing that came on them, using them so powerfully at one time, eventually destroy them. One can not combine the glory of God with the glory of man. It spells disaster! I do believe followers of Jesus are catching on, that in order to see a lasting move of God and His glory (heaven) manifested on the earth humility is a priority. In India and Nepal I have shared this principle time and time again with our leaders. Now Holy Spirit is using them powerfully. At times I just sit back and let Jesus' glory manifest through them. Sharmila says some of our most powerful meetings have been when I have not spoken. So true! On a consistent basis in our outreaches Jesus and or angels have been appearing to Hindus and Muslims and they have been saved, supernaturally healed or delivered.

In most Charismatic and Pentecostal circles there is a strong emphasis on the gifting

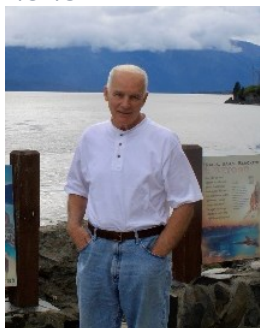
of an individual, with a very low emphasis on Christlike character. Romans 11:29 says *For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.* That is true. Today we see gifted people with great character flaws operating in the power of God and many Christians running after and hanging on every word they speak just because of the gifting of that individual. This is dangerous to the move of God. We can put pressure on leaders to perform with their gifting, for their own glory, set them up for the fall, then we stand back and point the finger, wondering how they could fall. What is more important to Christ our gifting or our character? Our character! We should never allow our gifting to surpass our character or we set ourselves up for the fall. At the same time we put a strong emphasis on character and right under that put a strong emphasis on gifting and anointing of Holy Spirit also.

In the early days of this ministry I permitted pride to blind me and rob me of the anointing that could have been on my life a lot earlier. I did not understand in those days how the glory of 'man' is a huge obstacle to seeing the glory of 'God' in full manifestation and on a continual basis. Putting a strong emphasis on character

will help us finish our course well.

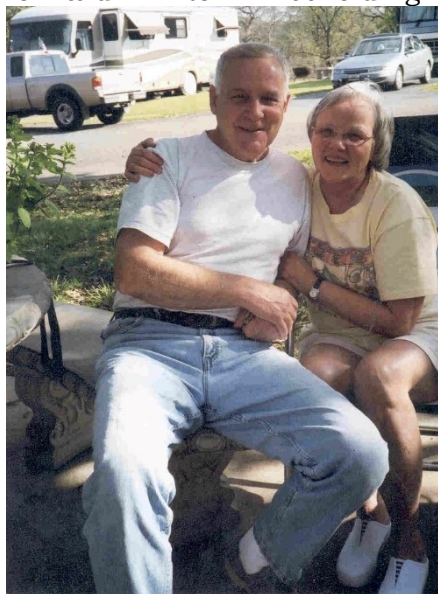
One of the best ways to be submitted and humble is with our own spouses. We can go a lot further by submitting to each other and lovingly speaking into each other's lives. This is a great way to grow spiritually and in our marriages. I often ask my wife (during prayer together) for her input in many of the ministry decisions to see if she has a green light to do something or if she has a check. I value her input as she flows much more in a prophetic anointing than I do, which will cause her to view things differently than I do. That is the uniqueness about marriage and having different giftings. It really helps us to make quality decisions together from different perspectives. This is why Paul tells us *submitting one to another in the fear of Lord* (Ephesians 5:21). He knew if we listened to each other we will be much more effective in the long run. Listening to Sharmila has helped sharpen me and caused me to be more effective in ministry. Listening to each other will help us finish our course well in this life. On May 20, 2025, we celebrated 30 years of a great marriage and partnership together.

## Remembering my Father John Anderson Sr January 26, 1935 - May 26, 2025



I am so honored to have had a godly father who led all 6 of his children into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. He taught us the difference between religion and having a personal relationship with Christ. All of us siblings are passionately in love with and serving Jesus. My parents did an excellent job of modelling the importance of living for Christ (the audience of ONE). My father passed into eternity on Memorial day **May 26, 2025**. On the morning of his passing he was surrounded by his wife and daughters. He pointed up into the ceiling as if someone was there. We told him if Jesus or angels were there, we give you permission to go with them. At 7:45pm I called my dad and my sister Darcia put the phone by his ear, so Sharmila and I could tell him how much we loved him and that he could go be with Jesus. At 8:15pm the silver cord of life was loosed (see

Ecclesiastes 12:6). My sister Julie was alone him, holding his forearm, singing Amazing Grace and Blessed Assurance. He took his last breath and went right into the presence of Jesus, the ONE he loved so much. He told us years ago *"do not cry for me when I leave this earth"* He was looking forward to beholding



Jesus face to face. It was a little difficult to obey that order as we cried tears of joy and released him to the Lord. He is greatly missed in this life, but we will see him on the other side.

My Father was very humble and rarely talked about any of his accomplishments. He was a stellar athlete in football, basketball and track. We had to probe and pry to find out



about his accomplishments. His company worked on computer systems for the Trident Submarine and Stealth Bombers. He loved running and entered several marathons.

My parents were approaching 70 years of marriage in August. My father and mother introduced me to healing ministry when they stood on the word of God for my mother's healing of cancer. They were given a great book by **Kenneth Hagin Sr** entitled **God's Medicine**. They devoured that little book and my mother said *"each day we took our Gospills."* One day the Doctor came in shocked and dumbfounded after running some tests on my mother. He said a mystery had taken place and my mother **suddenly** had no trace of cancer. She never had cancer again and is 92 years old.

I learned so many good life lessons from my loving father over the years. ## NEPAL REPORT

We conducted a pastors conference in **Bhadrapur, NEPAL March 3-5, 2025.** About 500, mostly senior pastors and their leaders attended hungry for teaching and training. Everything went smooth on the outside. Little did we know that Nepal militant Hindus, influenced by the BJP government in India

were trying to cause problems and complained to the CBI, (similar to the FBI) about us foreigners teaching in their city. Our coordinator, N. Binod did not let me know this was happening, but contacted his good friend the **Home Minister of Nepal, Ramesh Lekhak**. He is 2nd in command in the country, overseeing the police force and military. He told N. Binod that he would take care of the situation and we should proceed with the meetings. He instructed the CBI to desist from filing any charges against us. N. Binod met him in **Kathmandu** after our conference and thanked him personally. He mentioned he looks forward to meeting me and is interested in possibly attending our next leadership conference, in **Pokhara, Nepal**.

In my first session, I taught on the **Authority given to Mankind**. During the message I demonstrated how to take authority in Jesus name and release healing. I invited anyone who was deaf or partially deaf come forward. We demonstrated how to cast out a deaf spirit and had five testimonies of deaf ears opening immediately.

We have great favor in Nepal! **Pastor N. Binod** and his family with **Home Minister of Nepal Ramesh**

For this reason we have great favor in Nepal so we can do statewide leadership conferences and possibly open air outreaches in Nepal once again. Holy Spirit has greatly expanded Pastor N. ### **INDIA REPORT**

We had a powerful ministry time in **Himachal Pradesh State**, conducting two leadership conferences as well as a two day outreach in **Sundernagar**. About 75 people came to Christ. Christ confirmed His word with many signs following. In **Manali** we spent 2 entire days training about 60 pastors and leaders. Many were young men and

hungry for training. A number of pastors and leaders had encounters when we prayed over them for impartation. We conducted one morning of training pastors and leaders in **Sundernagar** and focused mainly on doing a 2 day outreach for the unsaved and encouraging the saints.

**Pastor Amar's** church was only around 60 people when we conducted our first of many outreaches in **Sundernagar** in 2013. Now he oversees 3 churches with around 1,000 members. Every time we minister there the church is jammed packed and with people sitting outside the windows (on the window ledges) and down the stairs. He has tried to get permission to build a church that could hold at least 1,000 people but the BJP Government will not allow him to extend his church building. During our meeting **Dhani Ram**, who had severe pain in back,
